A Milestone Moment for the UCSF- Washington Cancer Center

It's hard to believe that just over 1 year ago, in the summer edition of the Washington Health Foundation's Foundation Focus, the **UCSF** – **Washington Cancer Center Campaign** had reached a goal of \$10.5M. Your generosity helped us raise even more, reaching a total of over \$12M this summer! Construction on the new Cancer Center began in September 2024, and today, we are thrilled to announce that it will be completed in a few short months. The long-awaited, newly expanded Cancer Center will increase access to advanced treatment offered in partnership with UCSF Health, enabling patients to remain close to home, surrounded by their family and friends.

Set to open in early 2026, the 15,000 square foot center will include state-of-the-art technology and additional space for ongoing multidisciplinary collaboration and an expansive network of leading cancer care specialists.

The expansion was financed through a variety of sources, with an overall funding need of \$22M, and \$12M raised through philanthropy. The success of this transformational initiative has been supported by hospital staff, community members, local businesses, physicians, and countless other generous donors. Washington Health Trauma Center - Community Safety Fair


